## What should I already know?

## What will I find out?

South Africa 4 times larger than the UK but fewer people live there (around 10 million fewer).

South Africa has a sub-tropical and temperate climate (like ours). South Africa is in the southern hemisphere and has its seasons at different times of the year to us.

South Africa gets quite cold in winter (May-August), is warm and sunny in spring and autumn, and often hot in summer (November to March).

South Africa is diverse: traditional mud-built homes to skyscrapers, deserts to snow-topped Table Mountain, rural villages, to modern city streets, people in traditional and nontraditional dress.
