## Collective Worship - This week...

We continued our Worship series this week on 'The Word'. The children are really impressing us as we explore different bible verses! They are making links to their life and wider learning. They are exploring how they feel about the words.

We looked at the bible verse from Deuteronomy Chapter 10 verse 12, which says, 'What do you think God expects from you? Just this: Live in his presence in holy reverence, follow the road he sets out for you, love him, serve God, your God, with everything you have in you.'
