Vocabulary

Quilt	A multi-layered textile, traditionally composed of two or more layers of fabric or fibre, often used as a warm cover on a bed.
Narrative	A story
Fabric	Cloth made by weaving, knitting or pressing fibres together
Van Gogh	A famous Dutch painter who lived 1853 - 1890
Mona Lisa	The name of a famous painting by Leonardo da Vinci in 1503
We came to America	Name of a piece of quilt art by Faith Ringgold
Sunflower quilting bee at Aries	Name of a piece of quilt art by Faith Ringgold
Dancing at the Louvre	Name of a piece of quilt art by Faith Ringgold
