Vocabulary

Felt	A type of fabric where fibres have been pressed together
Needle	Metal implement for sewing
Thread	Thin cotton (or wool, silk or nylon) which can sew pieces of fabric together
fabric	Cloth made by weaving, knitting or pressing fibres together
Whipstitch	A stitch which passes over the edge of fabric
Back stitch	A stitch where the thread is sewn back and forward, creating a continuous line of stitches
Running stitch	A forward motion stitch which creates small gaps
Appliqué	A type of art which uses fabric sewn and/or glued together

- How to sew using whipstitch, back stitch and running stitch;
- How to draw a simple design to create an appliqué piece of art;
- How to choose colours to convey a mood
