

What should I already know?

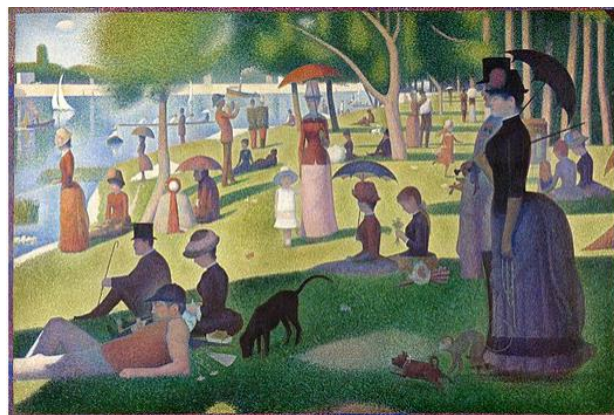
- You will know that the primary colours are red, blue and yellow;

- You will know how to mix black and white with primary colours to create shades and tints
- You will know how to use scissors carefully and accurately

- Secondary colours are green, orange and purple and these are made by mixing primary colours together

Vocabulary

Primary colours	Red, blue and yellow. They cannot be made by mixing any other colour
Secondary colours	Orange, green and purple. These are made by mixing two primary colours together
Loading	Putting paint onto the paintbrush
pointillism	The technique of painting with different coloured dots
