I believe using Live and Kicking would allow families to continue with after-school childcare to support working hours.

Some families have said that Live and Kicking are full, however, a telephone call with the Live and Kicking manager explains that this is not the case.

To support this, we have also reorganised our after-school club offer. Each week Will consist of two sessions up to 4:30 pm for EYFS to Year 3 and two sessions up to 4:30 pm for Years 4-6. There is a maximum of 20 places per club. We are hoping that this arrangement will help.





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
